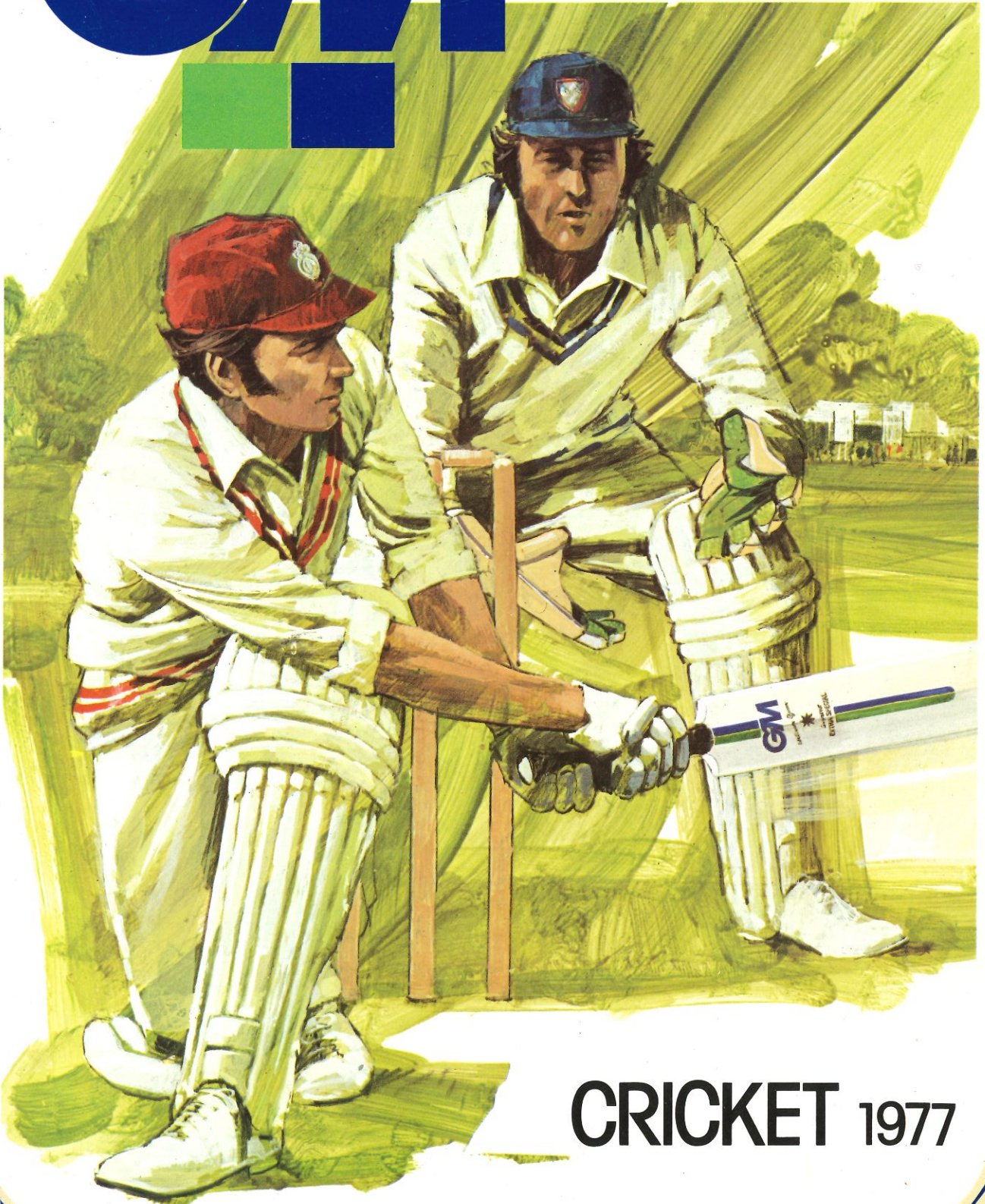

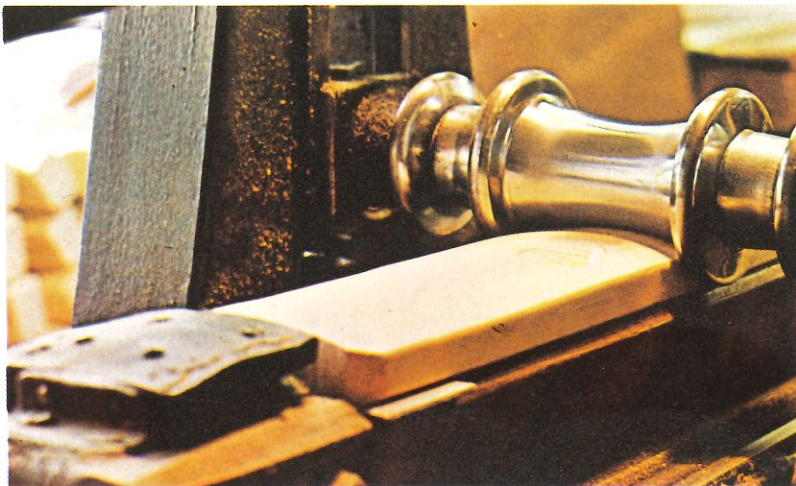

Important

Kashmir willow has some different characteristics to English willow. The faces of 'Scoremaster' bats are pressed to give a tough resilient surface, but because Kashmir willow is rather softer than English willow, in use indentations and some surface cracks will appear. Such facial markings should be ignored as they are normal for this type of willow and should not detract from the continuing good performance of the bat.

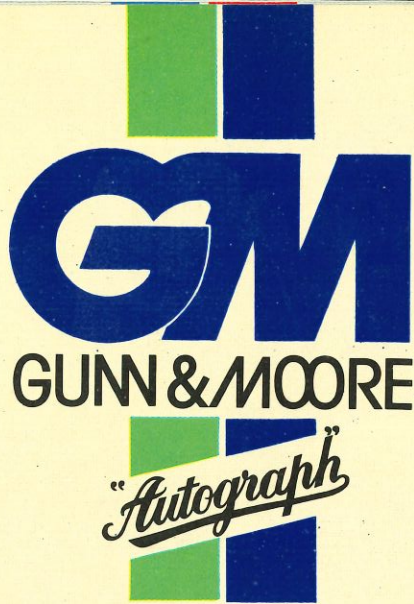

Technical Notes: Batting Gloves

Leather

Sheepskin, full chrome tanned. Special process oils give long lasting suppleness and ensure leather stretches and recovers with every movement of the hand.

Sheepskin has high tensile strength for tear resistance.

No dressing or salt is used in the preparation of the leather as these cause surface deterioration and stiffening in use. Drumming with a mixture of titanium oxide and french chalk gives improved surface and texture.

Padding

Model 05110 – fine texture sponge rubber.

Other models – Pure Kapok. Will not compact or become lumpy in use, as does cotton waste which is widely used.

Thread

Three ply core spun thread – a core of nylon and twin glazed cotton braiding. Cotton thread used alone is too weak to take the strains involved. Nylon thread used alone does not lay flat and may cut the material causing splitting in use.

Manufacture

Skins are preserved in batches, so that any pair of gloves is made out of one batch of skins thus preventing differential stretching and ensuring the maintenance of shape of finished glove and uniformity of texture and colour. Particular attention is paid at the cutting stage so that the natural stretch in the leather becomes available across the hand rather than in the direction from the wrist to the finger tips.

Wicket Keeping Gloves

Leather

Leather of the same characteristics as used for Batting Gloves is used, but from larger animal skins to give heavier duty leather.

On glove 05210 the full sheepskin leather lining is of extra supple quality.

Specially selected portions of the skins are used for the finger gussets which take tremendous strain.

Padding

Sponge Rubber and Pure Kapok are used in all models.

In model 05210 further protection is provided by selected strong cane firmly sewn in leather pockets.

Tapered rubber finger thimbles are used throughout.

Protective Equipment

The 'Autograph' range of protective equipment – for cricketers who demand the very best.

Technical Notes

External Covering

BUCKSKIN: Finest goat skin, flesh side outside, for increased tensile strength and wearing qualities.

CANVAS: Closely woven heavy canvas, peroxide bleached with a special dressing to prevent distortion both in manufacture and use.

PLASTIC: Heavy grained P.V.C., bonded to heavy cotton drill.

Padding

Padding is a fine yarn drill stuffed with Kapok, this stuffing being vastly superior to cotton waste being both lighter and non-compacting.

Cane

A split cane is used as opposed to a bamboo, this is stiffer and provides better protection. It is placed between the stiff lining of the pad and the stuffing for maximum protection. Many pads have a bamboo inside the stuffing which reduces its protective effect, but makes construction simpler and cheaper.

Straps

Full chrome cowhide fastened through three seams to spread the load.

Buckles

Zinc plated steel. The zinc plating gives much better rust protection than the normal thin nickel plating.

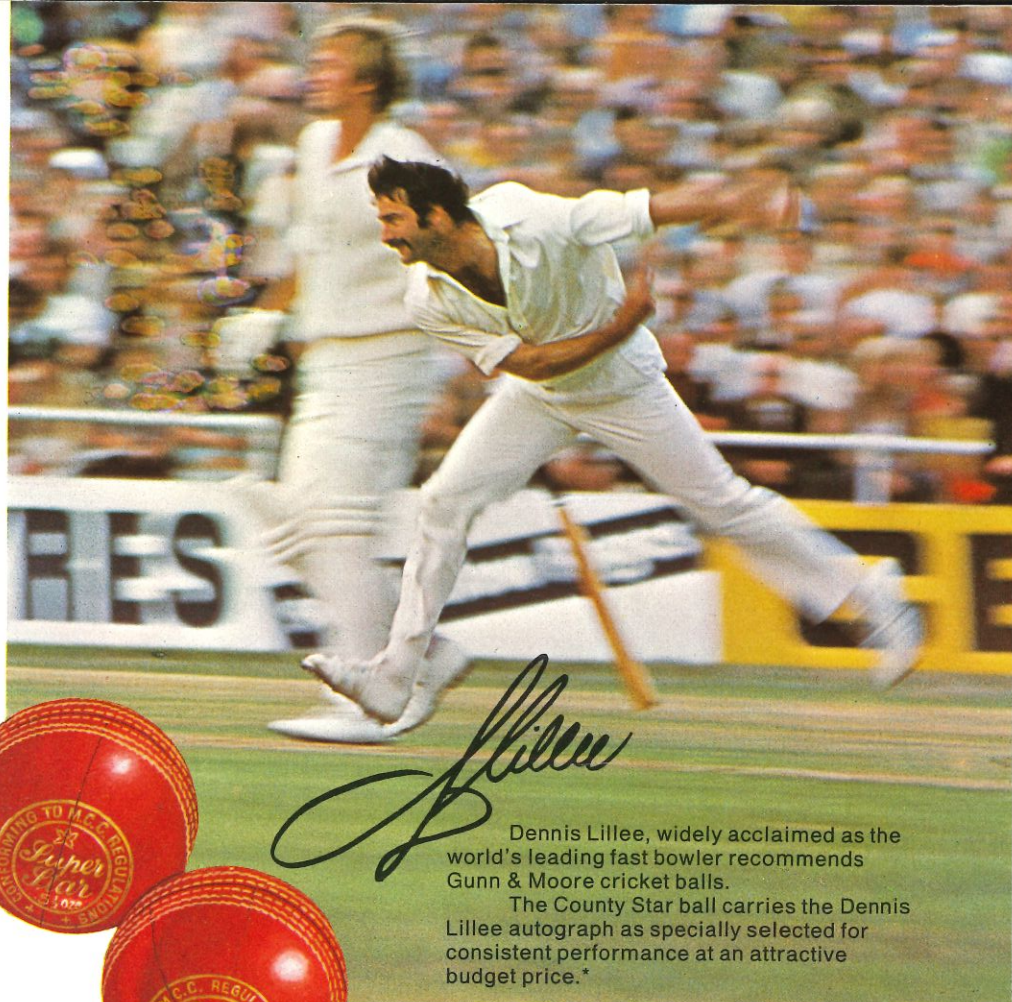
Buckles are riveted to straps as against the cheaper paper type fastener commonly used.

Technical Notes

All Gunn & Moore cricket balls are quartered balls, hand stitched. The centres are all constructed of wool and natural cork layers around a natural cork centre.

No composition centres are used in any ball.

Sample balls selected at random from each manufacturing batch are tested in actual play.

Strict quality control of both materials and construction methods ensure, as far as possible, perfect shape retained during play, true seams and avoidance of 'hard' balls to prevent bat damage.

Outer Case

Choicest butt leather, alum tanned, pre-treated for wet conditions and abrasive resistance and pre-stretched to avoid distortion in use.

The leather used for the Gunn & Moore range of cricket balls is graded from the top ball downwards, so that the Super County Ball is made from a very limited portion of the finest skins specially selected and superior in every respect and as the grading proceeds, other selected portions of the skin are used. It is to be emphasised, however, that even the lowest grade ball is made from a portion of a top quality skin.

Inner Core

All inner cores are made from layers of well oiled new wool and worsted yarn and natural cork around a cork centre. The cores are air dried for two to three months before being sewn in the case.

The baking of cores to accelerate drying is assiduously avoided, as this procedure destroys the resilience of both the wool and the cork making the finished ball hard.

Wool Layers in Core and Stitches in Seam

The number of layers of wool and cork and the number of stitches in the seam vary through the range as follows:-

A linen flax thread is used for sewing.

Re-blading

A new blade of any grade of bat described in this catalogue can be fitted to any handle regardless of make.

To ensure speedy service please label the bat giving full particulars of work required and stating the quality of blade to be fitted.

Let us know if new rubber handle grips are to be fitted.

The blades of bats sent for re-blading may be sawn off just below the splice to minimise cost of carriage.

If possible send the bat during the close season. It will enable us to provide you with a speedier service.

Re-handling

New handles can be fitted to any bat. We offer two qualities.

1. as fitted to our 'Autograph' carbon fibre bats or
2. as fitted to our 'Autograph' bats.

General Bat Repairs

Cracks and splits can be repaired by gluing and the addition of 1, 2 or 3 wraps.

We can also let pieces of willow into the blade or add an inset to the toe to extend the life of the bat.

Rawhide protection, as used in our Velhide Driver and Super Driver bats can be added to any bat.

Any bat can also be converted into a non-oil bat by the process used for our Polympic bat.
